Chiropractic has only one goal. It is critical to understand both the objective and the method that will be used to obtain it. This will prevent any confusion, or disappointment. The goal of the Cyriacks Chiropractic Office is to restore and maintain the integrity of the spinal cord and its nerve roots. These vital nerve pathways are located in, and protected by the bones of the spine. Misalignments of the vertebrae (bones of the spine) that interfere with the function of these nerve pathways are called *Vertebral Subluxations. Subluxations are caused by many of the things you do everyday, and keep your entire body from functioning properly. It is with absolute certainty that we can say that the body is always better off without this interference.

Therefore, the method used to reach the goal is to provide a chiropractic *adjustment to correct subluxation thereby restoring normal nerve function. It is not the objective or intention the Cyriacks Chiropractic Office to diagnose, or treat any disease or condition other than vertebral subluxation. We are not attempting to cure any physical, mental, or emotional ailments, nor are we giving advice about any ailments. However, if during the course of a chiropractic examination we encounter non-chiropractic, or unusual findings, we will recommend that you seek the services of a health care provider who specializes in the area.
